15 MIN Eat, Meet & Greet

15 MIN Ice Breaker: **Categories.** Divide into groups of about 5 members each, teaming with people they know the least. Instruct each team to find at least 6 things in common with every member. Don't use simple things like height, hair color, or clothing. Limiting the similarities to non-material things helps people learn more about each other and engage in active, more meaningful conversations that promote inclusion and lasting connections. The game ends once every team has come up with 6 things they have in common; the winner is the team that achieves the objective first.

NOTE Because of the nature of the questions this week, we strongly encourage gender-based small group breakout discussions over the content.

OPENING PRAYER

45–60 MIN IT'S TIME TO FAN THE FLAME REF: 2 Timothy 1

- Fire cannot continue without constant fuel.
- Don't settle for emptiness. REF: John 10:10

NEED FOR FATHERS. REF: 2 TIM. 1:2; ACTS 16:1-3

- This is a fatherless generation, but God is not absent, abusive, or aloof. We have a lot of mentors, but our greatest need is fathers. Mentors are people you can call. Fathers are people who call you. This generation likes to be mothered but not fathered. Paul gave his life away to the next generation.
- God can forgive and cleanse our conscience.

- Some don't know what their gift is. Some are unsure. Some are too scared. Some don't believe.

2. Our gift is for others. Ref: 1 Pet. 4:10
3. You can do this. Ref: 2 Tim. 1:7-14
