# Life Group Schedule

**15 MIN** Eat, Meet & Greet

**15 MIN** Ice Breaker Game: **52-Card Shuffle**. Each person receives a card from a normal deck; include the jokers as wild cards. Have all group members stand in an open area, holding their cards. Instruct the group to move into a variety of configurations and introduce themselves to the new person or group of people. Give the group a short topic to discuss, such as favorite food, book, movie, etc. Ideas for configurations: Cards with the Same Number, Suits, Straight, Full House. (Note: When some people are left without a match, help these orphans make a group of their own or join an existing group.)

## **OPENING PRAYER**

**45–60 MIN** “**EDIT IV—Q&A**”

- Q1.** How can you speak the truth in love in situations you’re currently facing? Discuss issues you’re facing, then talk about how Jesus would possibly walk through it, based on examples from Scripture.
- Q2.** Are there any steps you need to take regarding the condition of your heart prior to speaking the truth in love to someone else?

**1 COR 15:58** “Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.”

**HEB 4:12** “For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.”

**2 TIM 4:3** “For the time will come when people will not put up with sound doctrine. Instead, to suit their own desires, they will gather around them a great number of teachers to say what their itching ears want to hear.”

**HEBREWS 13:4** “Let marriage be held in honor among all, and let the marriage bed be undefiled, for God will judge the sexually immoral and adulterous.”

**MARK 10:6-9 6** “But at the beginning of creation God ‘made them male and female.’<sup>7</sup> ‘For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, **8** and the two will become one flesh.’ So they are no longer two, but one flesh. **9** Therefore what God has joined together, let no one

separate.”

**1 THES 4:3** “It is God’s will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; 4 that each of you should learn to control your own body in a way that is holy and honorable, 5 not in passionate lust like the pagans, who do not know God;”

**1 CORINTHIANS 6:19-20** “Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; 20 you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.”

**ROM 14:1** “Accept him whose faith is weak, without passing judgment on disputable matters.”

**1 PETER: 5:8-9** “Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. 9 Resist him, firm in your faith.”

**1 TIM 3:8** “In the same way, deacons are to be worthy of respect, sincere, not indulging in much wine, and not pursuing dishonest gain.”

**2 CORINTHIANS 13:5** “Examine yourselves as to whether you are in the faith. Test yourselves. Do you not know yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you?”

**MATTHEW 7:21-23** “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. 22 Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ 23 And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’”

**PHIL 3:20** “Our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ.”

**JOHN 14:2-3** “In my Father’s house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.”

**REVELATION 21:4** “He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.”
