MARK 1: 40-45

Q1. WHAT IS THE DEFINITION OF GRACE AND MERCY

GRACE IS A GIFT WE DON'T DESERVE

MERCY IS NOT GETTING THE PUNISHMENT WE DESERVE (FORGIVENESS)

- See the mercy of Christ and be merciful - we need to take the ideas and convictions from Jesus' teaching and turn it into spiritual maturity inside of us.

Q2. ARE YOU EXTENDING MERCY AND LOVING YOUR ENEMIES? IF YES, TELL US HOW. IF NO, SHARE HOW YOU CAN GROW IN THIS AREA.

- To receive mercy, we need to be merciful - even when we despise someone's opinion or what they post on social media.
- Christ knows we need to learn this from his teaching, that's why the story is told several times in the Gospels.

THREE THINGS ABOUT LEPROSY:

1. It Killed the Soul First

Q3. HOW IS LEPROSY IN THE DAYS OF JESUS RELATED TO THE SIN OF OUR LIVES TODAY?

IT TAKES AWAY OUR COUNTENANCE, OUR SOUL, THE WAY WE THINK, THE WAY WE LIVE AROUND OUR EMOTIONS.

LEV 13:46

- labeled "unclean"

LEPROSY WAS A SIGN OF MORAL FAILURE. IMAGINE EVERYONE THINKING YOU HAD FAILED!

Q4. HAVE YOU EVER HAD ANYTHING HAPPEN TO YOU THAT YOU KNEW WAS BAD FOR YOU PHYSICALLY, BUT YOU COULD TELL THAT IT WAS GOING TO CHANGE YOUR SOUL? (MAYBE YOU HAD AN EXPERIENCE WHERE YOUR LIFE FLASHED BEFORE YOU.)

SIN LIKE LEPROSY CAN AFFECT YOUR RELATIONSHIPS AND HOW YOU COMMUNICATE WITH OTHERS.

2. Leprosy Erodes the Body

Q5. DO YOU NEED TO APPROACH THE LORD AND ASK FOR HIM TO TOUCH YOU AGAIN? EXPLAIN.

THIS IS A SERIOUS SEASON WE ARE LIVING IN; WE ARE LIVING WITHOUT THE MERCY AND HAVE FORGOTTEN THE GRACE, AND WHAT SIN TRIES TO DO TO US.

LEV 13:46

MARK 1:40-42

3. Leprosy caused Spiritual Separation

Q6. HAS THERE BEEN A TIME WHEN YOU FELT SPIRITUALLY SEPARATED FROM GOD OR THE CHURCH?

SIN CAUSES SPIRITUAL SEPARATION

- When you give your heart to the Lord, there is so much mercy that is handed to you that when the Father looks at you, he sees his Son! Jesus traded places with us!
- Nothing can compete with that mercy

Q7. Is there someone you hurt or created pain in their life? Is there a way for you to resolve it?

THINK OF SOMEONE YOU MAY BE AVOIDING, SEPARATED FROM

- Ask God to give you mercy and the opportunity to repent and ask for forgiveness.
- Sometimes the mistakes we make, we just can not pay the price for them. You can not just take care of your own sin. God needs to be in on the healing.

Q8. Why should we worship in the pain verses only worshipping when we feel His blessing?

THE BEST WORSHIP YOU WILL EVER HAVE IN YOUR LIFE IS WHEN YOU WORSHIP IN THE PAIN.

- Because He knows exactly what we want, but we need to tell him. "Lord, if you are willing..." MARK 1:40

Q9. Have you been given compassion and shown mercy that you can tell others about? A time when you needed grace and mercy and God gave it to you? Share your story.

Q10. Do you have sin you need to cry out? Do you need the Lord's mercy toward that sin because you have been running from Him? Do you recognize that His compassion is trying to reach you this day? Ask God to help you by repenting of your current sin.

WE ARE ALL LIKE A LEPER IN TERMS OF OUR SIN AND THE DEGRADATION OF OUR SIN AND THE WAY WE LIVE; UNCLEAN, WITHOUT GOD. WE HAVE NO CHANCE WITHOUT HIS MERCY.

- Please don't be one who thinks He can't reach you. When you think that way, it's like you are saying the cross was not enough.
- Jesus KNOWS we need mercy

HEB 13: 5

 - › Do not share anything that will embarrass anyone, including your spouse.
 - › If called on you may pass on any questions you do not want to answer.
 - › Allow time for everyone to share; do not dominate the conversation.
 - › What is said in the group stays in the group. Use common sense and know when something shared is personal and should remain confidential.
